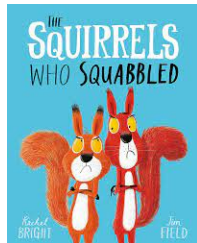
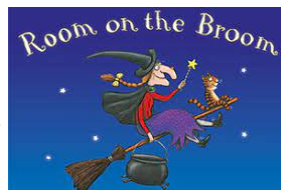

Understanding The World

The children will continue to explore the world around them. They will be introduced to the seasonal changes from Summer to Autumn to Winter. We will explore family customs and celebrations including Christmas and Remembrance Day.

- Autumn - looking at the changes we can see and feel
- Halloween - explore pumpkins
- Remembrance Day
- Christmas and family celebrations and traditions
- Visit a local Church - the world around us

Expressive Arts & Design

- Explore colours and creating new colours
- Use our bodies to move to music, join in and sing along to favourite songs and rhymes
- Create collages using a wide range of media and materials (natural objects)
- Explore the artist Georgia O'Keefe - Autumn Leaves



Maths

- Counting 1-5 in order and beginning to be able to count 1-10
- Use songs and rhymes to help learn number order - Five little ducks

Communication and Language

- Create opportunities for children to speak and listen to one another
- Begin to develop an understanding of sounds in name
- Begin with SATPIN phonics - Rising 5's will be introduced to the letters, S,A,T,P,I,N gradually

Literacy (See book list)

- Explore books and how to care for them, turning pages carefully and one at a time and to be able to hold books the correct way turn
- Name Recognition
- Begin to understand how a book holds information
- Show a preference to favourite books
- Share stories with friends

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Children will learn about their families and family traditions -children will be able to talk freely about their home and family
- Develop sharing and turn taking skills
- Begin to control feelings and have a better understanding of why they feel that way
- Children will begin to understand the feelings of others and how they can help them
