

Remote Learning Expectations

Boudica Schools Trust expects its schools to offer remote learning that:

- Is high quality
- Is appropriate to the age of the learner
- Is appropriate to, and in line with, the school's curriculum
- Is compatible with the quality of WIFI/4G connectivity in the school's catchment area
- Takes into account the availability of devices in different family homes
- Is flexible to reflect the needs of the curriculum and the learners
- Offers varied tasks and delivery methods
- Is mindful of screen time for both learners and their teachers
- Is mindful of support available at home
- The same content that is delivered in school to Critical Worker and Vulnerable Children.
- Based upon the teachers' knowledge of the learners and the best way to extend and support their learning.

The Department for Education expects remote learning hours to be:

- KS1: 3 hours a day on average across the cohort, with less for younger children
- KS2: 4 hours a day
- KS3 & 4: 5 hours a day

It is not the expectation in BST schools that these hours are all face to face, live or video provision but the total amount of learning time each day which will include independent learning.

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
